



Aims and Progress

1. Compare outcomes for infants born with very low birth weight neonates (weighing <1500 g) and very preterm (<32 weeks gestation) among national neonatal networks spanning various countries.

2. Identify site-level physical, human, and environmental characteristics, as well as care practices that are associated with variations in outcomes.

3. Identify clinical and organizational practice improvements relevant to each network.

4. Implement and continually evaluate the impact of evidence-based clinical and organizational practice changes in NICUs within the iNeo networks.

Ongoing Plans

The overarching goal is to engage in continued collaboration and to extend the linkage of survey data to outcome data. Outcomes will be evaluated based on specific survey characteristics and networks will work on developing a follow-up cohort, as well as distribution of annual reports. Comparison of developmental outcomes and development of quality improvement activities in each country are next goals.
